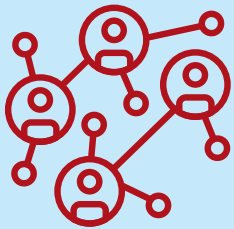

NETWORKING & NETWEAVING



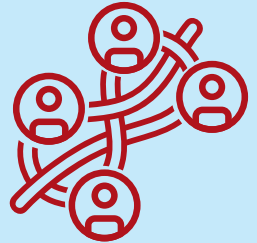
NETWORKING:
